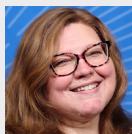

The mailroom is located inside The Connection Bookstore within the Student Center. The mailroom sells stamps, envelopes and boxes, and packing materials and shipping tape are available for use.

If a student receives a package with a tracking number, the mailroom will send a notification email to the student's OCU email account upon arrival. If the package is too large to fit into the combination mailbox it will be held for pickup in the mailroom. Mailroom staff will only release mail to the individual to whom it is addressed. Student ID is required to pick up mail and packages.

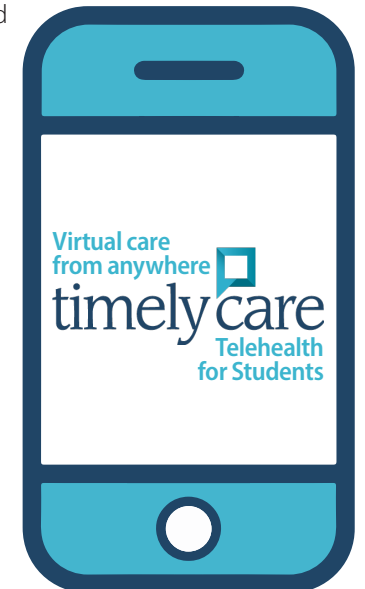

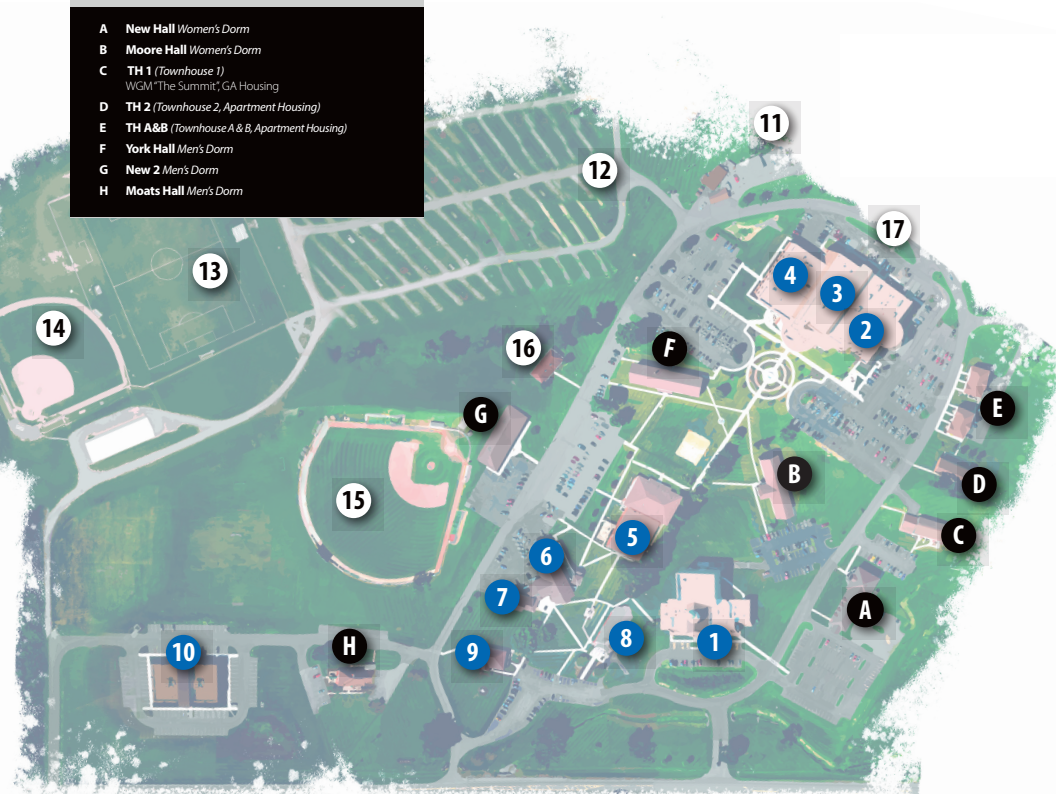
