

Trailblazer Safe Six

WHILE ON CAMPUS:

1. Always Wear Your Face Covering

Face coverings are required. If you have a reason to request an exception to wearing a face covering, reach out to complianceofficer@ohiochristian.edu. In addition, face coverings should never be worn by or placed on people who are younger than 2, have difficulty breathing, or are unconscious, incapacitated or otherwise unable to remove them without assistance.

2. Check Your Temperature Once a Day

Whether in your dorm or in the building of your first class, you must check your temperature before walking around campus or attending class. If your temperature is at or above 100.0 degrees, reach out to Student Development. All members of the university community must self-monitor daily for symptoms. Employees and students who have probable connection to or has confirmed COVID-19 will be asked to self-quarantine in their own home.

3. Use ENTRANCE Doors to Enter and EXIT Doors to Leave

Everyone must use entrance and exit doors as are labeled. This small inconvenience can make all the difference. Keep each other accountable and use the doors as they are marked.

4. Wash Your Hands Frequently

Everyone must rigorously practice hand hygiene and cough etiquette. Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after you have been in a public place, or after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing. Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth with unwashed hands. If soap and water are not available, use a hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol.

5. Clean and Sanitize

Everyone will clean and sanitize any area they use where the supplies are provided. All employees will be required to clean and sanitize their workspaces and common spaces throughout the day. Faculty will be cleaning and sanitizing the instructor's area and the student area and desks in the classroom after each class.

6. Stay 6 Feet Apart

Physical distancing guidelines will be strictly enforced, requiring individuals to maintain at least 6 feet of separation from others. Pay attention to where you are to sit in classrooms, where to stand for lines, and general social distancing at 6 ft apart at all times.
